- Discover INSA Lyon, a place where you may want to come back for an academic exchange, a Master of Science Degree, a Post-Master or a PhD!









Competitiveness clusters in France Created in 2005 by the French government Objective: to galvanize the community of innovation players into collaborating as effectively as possible

Greater Lyon alone has 5 competitive clusters, 2 of them on a global scale.

Over the last three years, 300 million euros worth of projects have been approved by the 5 clusters.




